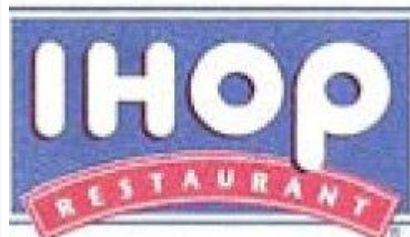

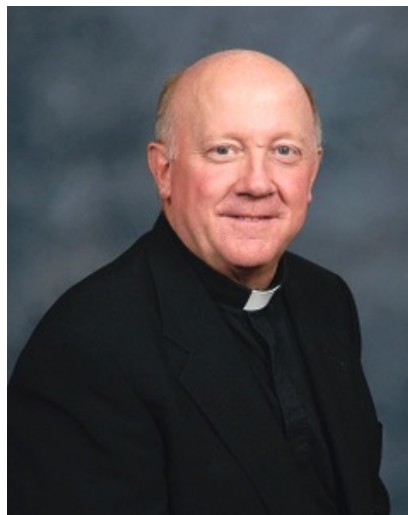
Resolution for Council #13576 Name Change
