- 1. Tabernacle in the center of sanctuary. Tabernacle to be the focus.

- 4. Re-use of stained glass
- 5. Incorporate elements of existing church
- 6. Pews that fit the sizes of modern people
- 7. Inproved acoustics

- 11. Circular (fan shaped) seating is distracting.
