- 1. How do we incorporate God's creation
- 2. How do we bring nature into the church
- 3. Natural creation shown and represented within the church
- 4. Adoration chapel (Fremont and Martyrs as example). Special space with outside entrance.
- 5. Music area located to left or right of altar
- 6. St. Patrick's story told in windows, structure, art, building form
- 7. Incorporate ancestor's memories and stories. History woven into project
- 8. Save old altars for use somewhere in the building.
- 9. New altars of stone.
- 10. Cry room designed for kids and parents. Sight lines for kids. Sound proof, private and comfortable.
- 11. Narthex as a spiritual space that leads you to the nave and onto the sanctuary. Less cluttered as current space.
- 12. Narthex that is bigger to serve the parish. Spaces for information display.
- 13. Baptismal space defined and special
- 14. Church entry that incorporates a court yard that could serve church and school.
- 15. Marian garden
- 16. Choir loft with organ that uses the school elevator.
- 17. Current altar has storage built in.
- 18. Storage located close to need/use.
- 19. Old stained glass windows incorporated with better lighting.
- 20. Accessible lighting
- 21. Exterior lighting
- 22. Traditionally styled church.
